More than \$10 billion in census-guided federal assistance distributed over decade

In 2020, the US Census Bureau will implement new technology for the first time.

Community Stakeholders will be able to respond by mail, phone as well as by way of the internet.

- Mid March 2020: Census count starts in Remote Alaska
- Materials mailed to most homes in 3 waves over ~7 days
- People can self-respond through July



20% of homes also get paper form in 1st mailing.



Telephone response option also available to all



80% of homes get letter inviting Internet response.

Note: Residents will receive a paper form eventually if they don't respond on-line or by phone.












Community Focus - New Orleans (Census Data, 2017 est)

- Population: 343,829 (+49,463 ppl) (52.3% women)
- Rate of Homeowners: 47.1% (-16.7%)
- Median Household Income: \$38,721 (-\$18,931K)
- Households with Computers: 79.1% (-8.1%)
- Households with Broadband: 66.1% (-12%)
- Education/Graduation Rates: 85.9% (+1.1%)
- Education/BA: 36.5% (+5.6%)




