**2020 Census Invitation** Letters have been mailed out and residents will receive them between March 12-20, 2020.

- When residents receive their invitation letters they will receive important Census information including a **Census ID** (personalized code).
- Use your '**Census ID**' to fill out your 2020 Census form over the phone or online if you feel the need to or if door to door Census enumeration operations are disrupted for some reason or another related to the spread of **Coronavirus (Covid-19, CDC)**. (**SitReps**)
- It is still vital that we not only fill out our Census forms, but not forget that over **\$1trillion** can be leveraged across the nation to support Coronavirus response, recovery and other desired healthcare needs.

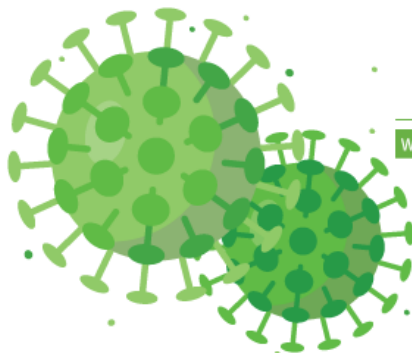

#### Prevention

When visiting affected areas
